CPNP Program

CPNP (Canadian Prenatal-Nutrition Program). Through this program, mothers receive a grocery gift card every month from the beginning of the pregnancy until the baby is 1 years old. Nutrition and food safety is discussed, as the purpose of these grocery cards is to promote good prenatal nutrition and healthy eating while breastfeeding.

Car Seat Loaning Program

Using the right car seat and installing it correctly is an important part of ensuring a child's safety! A variety of car seat

types and sizes are available on loan. Car seats are to be cleaned and returned when they are no longer being used or a new size is needed. Several staff members are certified in teaching families how to install car seats.



Breast Pump Prescription

The community health nurse can write prescriptions, that are covered under NIHB, for a breast pump for expecting mothers every new pregnancy. The option for manual, electric, single and double breast pumps are available.
